

- 3. Unloading ramp next to the poultry pavilion
- 4. Please unload, park and enter and pay at the Krieg Gate, Factory Street
- 5. The Stewards have the right to reject any sheep or place them in a different class.
- 6. All stock to be from brucellosis accredited flock. A Brucellosis certificate will be requested on arrival.
- 7. All exhibitors to be registered with their respective breed society.
- 8. OJD accredited studs will also be accommodated.
- 9. Limit of 3 entries per class per exhibitor.
