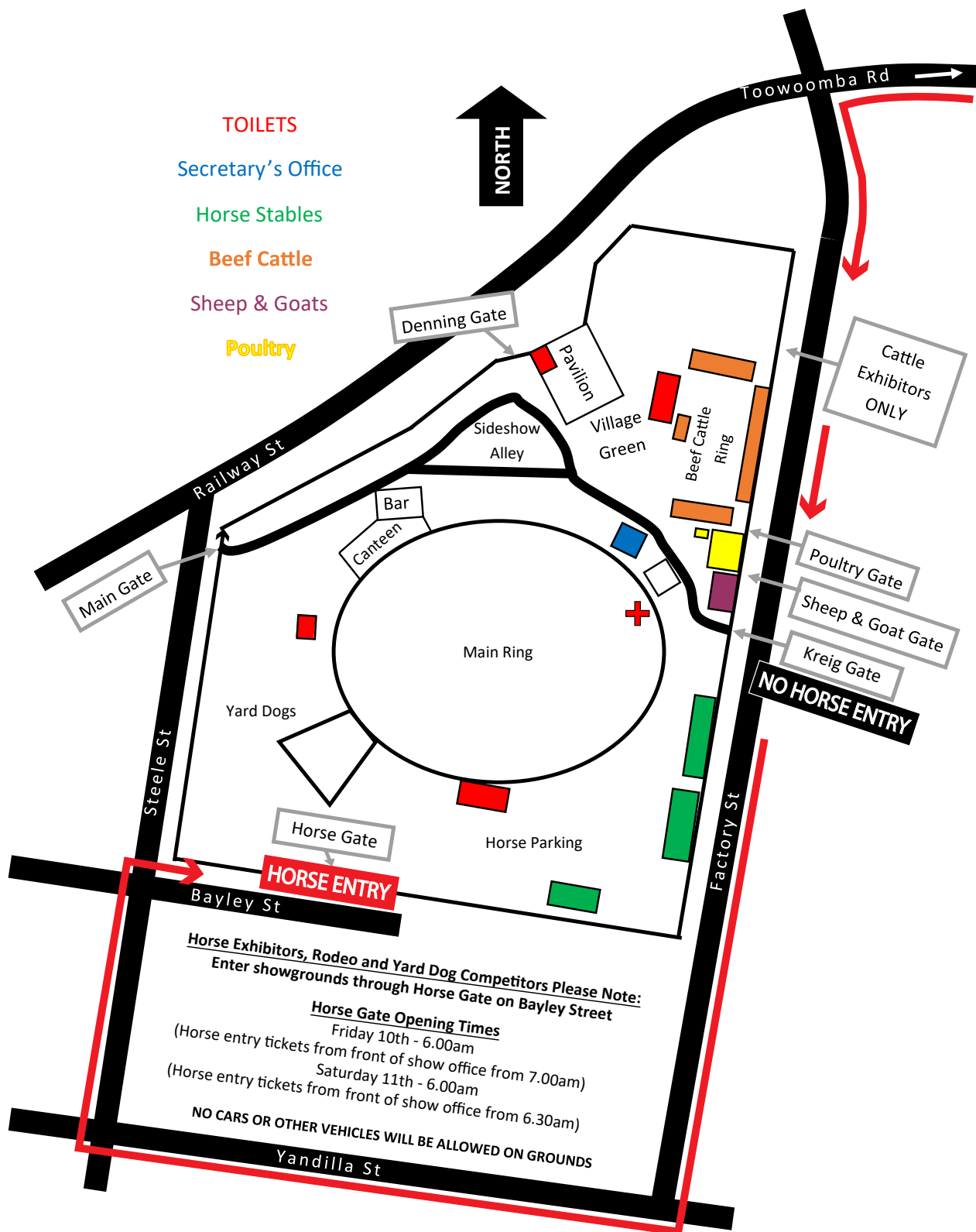

## *Poultry, Pigeon and Caged Birds Conditions of entry*

(For the conduct of Poultry and Caged Birds competitions at QCAS-affiliated Queensland Agricultural Shows)  
The following regulations apply to all poultry and caged bird competitions held at Queensland Agricultural Shows, subject to the Rules, By-Laws, and Regulations of the **Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc. (QCAS)** and the local **Agricultural Society**. In the case of a conflict, the rules of the affiliated Agricultural Society shall prevail.

These regulations must be read in conjunction with the **General Regulations** contained in this schedule.

### **1. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

- Birds may only be removed from the showing area with permission from the **Chief Steward**.
- Birds entered in the incorrect class may be reclassified at the discretion of the **Chief Steward**.
- Birds must not be handled or removed without the **Steward's** permission.
- Any bird found to have been **tampered with** may be disqualified at the discretion of the **Stewards and Committee**.
- **Eggs** laid during the show remain the property of the affiliated Agricultural Society.
- **Trimming, plucking, dyeing of feathers, leg staining, or any fraudulent practice** is strictly prohibited.
- **Exhibitors** are responsible for ensuring their exhibit is presented in the best condition. **Dubbing of male game fowl and game bantams is permitted**.
- **Only purebred birds** will be accepted for judging—crossbreeds are **not permitted**.
- **Banded birds** are eligible for judging.
- **Junior Exhibitors** must pen and unpen their own entries.

### **2. AGE CLASSIFICATION**

- Birds **12 months** and over will be judged as **adults**.

### **3. JUDGING RULES**

- Judging will be conducted under the **Australian Poultry Standard** or, where applicable, the **British Poultry Standard**.
- **Exhibitors must not communicate with Judges** during the judging process.
- Judges **cannot** judge any class in which they have entered.
- Exhibitors **must not enter a bird** in a class where:
  - The bird has been **owned or leased** by the Judge or their **immediate family**.
  - The Judge is the Exhibitor's **employer or business partner**.
- Exhibitors **cannot** enter if they or their bird have received **tuition from the Judge** or their business partner **within three (3) months prior to or during the show**.
- Exhibitors **cannot** compete if they have been **employed by or partnered** with the Judge **within three (3) months prior to or during the show**.
- Judges **must not visit** the poultry section or discuss any bird entered prior to or during judging.

### **4. BIOSECURITY REQUIREMENTS**

- All QCAS-affiliated **Agricultural Societies** follow a comprehensive **Agricultural Show Biosecurity Plan**. All event **organisers, competitors, and spectators** are responsible for its implementation.
- All birds must be **free of lice and disease**. Any bird showing signs of illness must be:
  - **Removed to a quarantine area** immediately.
  - **Collected by the owner** as soon as possible.

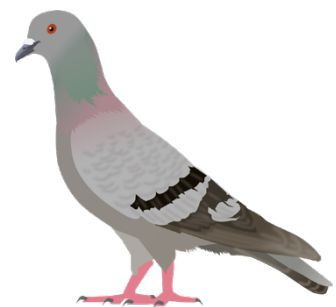

1. Please make entries early as no late entries will be accepted.
2. Poultry Pavilion opens at **6:30AM SATURDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> MARCH** and all exhibits must be ready for **JUDGING BY 9AM ON SATURDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2025.**
3. Strictly Saturday morning penning only. No Friday night penning.
4. All birds to be free of vermin and sickness or entries will not be penned.
5. Exhibits may only be collected after presentation of trophies at 3pm.
6. The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into
7. The Steward and Committee reserve the right to return entries with no correspondence entered.
8. Juniors must be under 16 years of age at the time of show and must be noted on entry form.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for supplying water bowls and watering their own exhibits.
10. **Please list colour as well as breed on your entry form, extra classes will be created where there are six or more entries of the one colour or variety in a class.**
