- 2. All grain must be of current seasons growth, free from weevils and must be of specified weight.
- 3. The stewards reserve the right to reject any grain showing weevils, also exhibits of insufficient weight or size. All exhibits to be chemical free.
- 4. Points for special trophies to be allocated 2 points for first, 1 point for second.
- 5. Wheat to be judged on the following scale of points: Condition 60 (made up as follows: colour 15, plumpness of grain 15, freedom from foreign matter 15, trueness of type 15); Freedom from Mottle 20 points, weight 20 points (2 points to be allowed for every kilogram per HL over 74 kg per HL); Total 100
